# St Luke 20: 27-38

<sup>27</sup> Then some of the Sadducees, who deny that there is a resurrection, came to *Him* and asked Him, <sup>28</sup> saying: "Teacher, Moses wrote to us *that* if a man's brother dies, having a wife, and he dies without children, his brother should take his wife and raise up offspring for his brother. <sup>29</sup> Now there were seven brothers. And the first took a wife, and died without children. <sup>30</sup> And the second took her as wife, and he died childless. <sup>31</sup> Then the third took her, and in like manner the seven also; and they left no children, and died. <sup>32</sup> Last of all the woman died also. <sup>33</sup> Therefore, in the resurrection, whose wife does she become? For all seven had her as wife."

<sup>34</sup> Jesus answered and said to them, "The sons of this age marry and are given in marriage. <sup>35</sup> But those who are counted worthy to attain that age, and the resurrection from the dead, neither marry nor are given in marriage; <sup>36</sup> nor can they die anymore, for they are equal to the angels and are sons of God, being sons of the resurrection. <sup>37</sup> But even Moses showed in the *burning* bush *passage* that the dead are raised, when he called the Lord 'the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.' <sup>38</sup> For He is not the God of the dead but of the living, for all live to Him."
